he story of the birth of Loma Linda is replete with a series of bankruptcies followed by providential beginnings. In an earlier article in this series we mentioned some of these early attempts at trying to make Loma Linda into a lucrative health resort. ut with each failed attempt the local area residents began to call the place Lonesome Linda.

uring the first five years of the twentieth-century eventh-day dventist cofounder llen . hite prophetically described a series of properties in outhern alifornia. uring those early years she guided church leaders to properties located both in an iego aradise alley ospital and lendale lendale dventist edical enter that uickly thrived as patients came for treatment. et she continued to appeal for yet another property that she said would providentially become available.

s she made her appeals the local dventist church leadership wondered how they could afford another institu-
